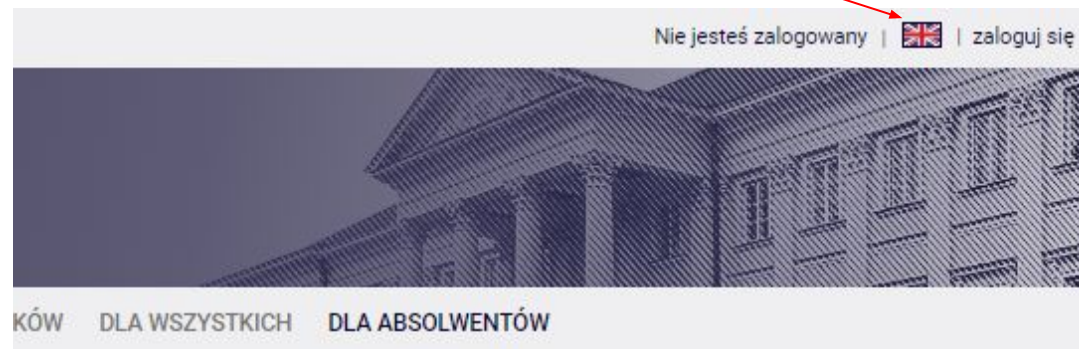

USOSweb - data migration

USOSweb (system for students and teachers) and **USOS** (database) exchange information during data migrations

Data migration take place everyday, around 4-5 AM

Information updated in USOS is visible in USOSweb next day (and vice-versa)

Data migration is especially important during registration.

Reporting a problem in the same day as registration start means that any fix will be available next day and can prevent access to registration.

Reporting problems as soon as they are occur is critical.

USOSweb - problems, errors

All information in USOSweb need to be verified often.

If any action in USOS is taken, need to check if its correctly visible in USOSweb

Reporting problems as soon as they are occur is critical. Solving a problem may be more difficult as the time pass.

Full description:	This course is intended to introduce students to the most essential academic skills of oral presentation and academic writing in psychology. It is designed, so that it should appeal both to students who struggle with essay writing, and to those who are eager to improve their skill even further. First, we will cover the principles of academic writing, with the aim of developing both conceptual and linguistic clarity. Second, we will focus on oral presentations, from idea building, through visual techniques, to managing stress. Throughout the semester, students will be working on their individual essay topic. They will complete a number of in-class and homework assignments in the process, culminating in the submission of the essay and the final presentation.

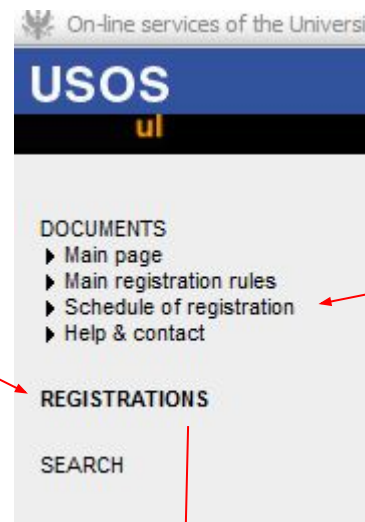
