

Supplementary information on the Regulations for student internships carried out within the psychology studies.

The possibility of recognizing the completion of student internships in relation to activities undertaken by students participating in the activities of Student Government and Scientific Circles of the Faculty of Psychology University of Warsaw in accordance with the Regulations for student internships adopted by the Teaching Council for the majors of psychology and applied animal psychology, for activities for the benefit of the University, i.e. in the Student Government and Scientific Circles, students can receive ECTS points.

1. Tasks performed as part of work in study clubs that can be shown as elements of student practice are:

- activity in the Board of the circle
- taking care of the circle's finances
- coordinating an event, conference
- participation in a given project
- organization of events
- organizing the integration of the wheel
- promoting the activities of the circle and the Faculty.

2. Tasks performed as part of work in the Student Government, which can be shown as elements of student practice are:

- activity in the bodies of the self-government and the faculty
- creation of counter-affidavits for orders (financial matters)
- organization of events
- acting in a given committee of the local government and completing tasks dedicated to the given commission/coordinated by the person who chairs the commission
- organization of integration of the local government
- promoting the activities of the Student Government and the Faculty of Psychology

3. Activities listed in points 1 and 2 are open catalogs - the final recognition of tasks is made by the relevant bodies.

4. The activity of a person is confirmed, in the case of a scientific circle - the management/president of the circle in consultation with the circle's scientific supervisor, in the case of the Student Government - the Student Government Council Student Government - the Council of Student Government of the UW Psychology Department and the Dean for student affairs. If necessary, the relevant body may ask for additional information from the person coordinating a given project or the person chairing a given section in the circle/government.

5. Activity for one year is required, active work is to last a minimum of 2 semesters. Activity can also be demonstrated by active participation in a certain number of projects and by creating attendance lists for mandatory meetings.

6. You can receive a maximum of 4 ECTS points.

7. The opinion confirming the above-mentioned activities is issued in the case of a scientific circle - the circle's supervisor together with the Board, and in the case of the Self-Government, the Dean for student affairs together with the Students Council. On the certificate there is to be a qualitative assessment and the following is to be written out individual tasks that have been performed. The person planning to pass the practice based on the above-mentioned activities, is required to keep a record of his activities

8. The practice supervisor in the case of the Circle becomes the Circle Supervisor, and in the case of the Self-Government - Dean for student affairs.

9. The inclusion of student internships, together with the ECTS points assigned to them, in the program of study study program is made based on the decision of the Dean for student affairs.
